Healthy condition

In the past few years, the incidence of concussion in the United States has increased significantly. Concussion is a mild form of traumatic brain injury that can cause a variety of symptoms, including headache, dizziness, and confusion. In severe cases, it can lead to permanent brain damage.

Diagnosis

Medical history and physical examination are the mainstays of diagnosis. The history should include the mechanism of injury, the onset of symptoms, and the duration of symptoms. The physical examination should focus on the head, neck, and eyes. A neurological examination, including a test of consciousness, is also important.

There are several tests that can be used to help diagnose concussion. These include the Glasgow Coma Scale, the Modified Glasgow Coma Scale, and the Concussion Assessment and Telemedicine Scale. These tests are used to assess the patient's level of consciousness and to track the patient's recovery over time.

There are several signs of concussion that can be observed in a patient. These include headache, dizziness, and confusion. In severe cases, there may be vomiting, loss of consciousness, and seizures.

All concussion cases should be treated as if they are severe until proven otherwise. The patient should be kept in a hospital or observation unit until they are fully recovered.
